- US retailers surprised with their second quarter earnings and made moves to adapt to a shifting landscape. Macy's will shut 100 stores by the end of this fiscal year; Disney bought a \$1B stake in streaming video company BAMTech; Wal-Mart spent \$3B on jet.com in an effort to take on Amazon.
- US retail sales were flat in July.
- Japan's national debt climbs to more than 240% of GDP, the most in developed world.
- Bank of England's QE failed to purchase all the bonds it wanted last week due to liquidity issues.

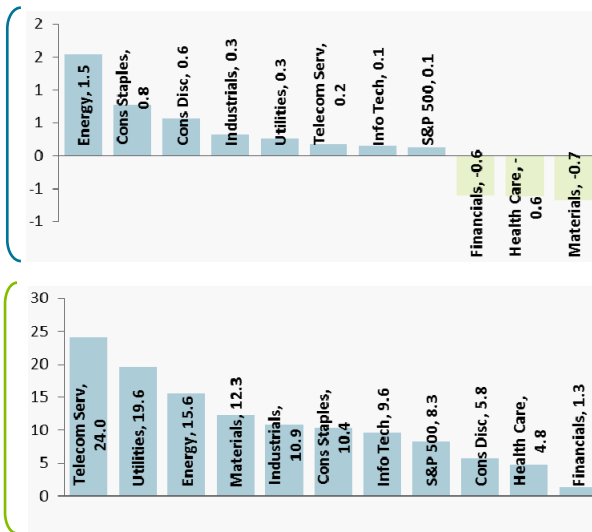

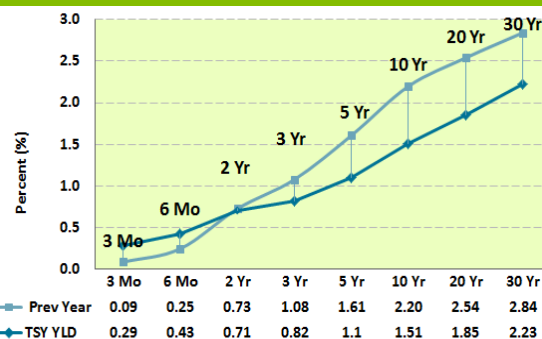
