

**News Headlines**

- Last week a series of earthquakes occurred in the Mojave Desert about 120 miles north of Los Angeles.
- The U.S. Women’s Soccer Team defeated the Netherlands 2 – 0 to win the Women’s World Cup.
- Pro-business leader, Kyriakos Mitsotakis, of the center-right New Democracy Party will be Greece’s next prime minister after his party won nearly 40% of the vote on Sunday.

**Economic News**

- The U.S. economy added 224,000 non-farm payroll jobs in June, which was well above forecasts.
- The share of voluntary job-leavers among the unemployed reached its highest level since 2000 at 14.7%, suggesting confidence in the labor market.
- U.S. exports rose by \$4.2B in May. In spite of this the trade deficit widened to \$55.5B as imports grew by \$8.5B.

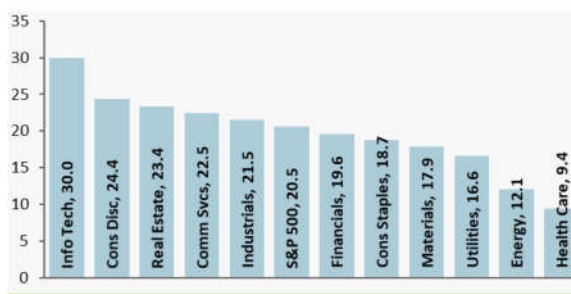

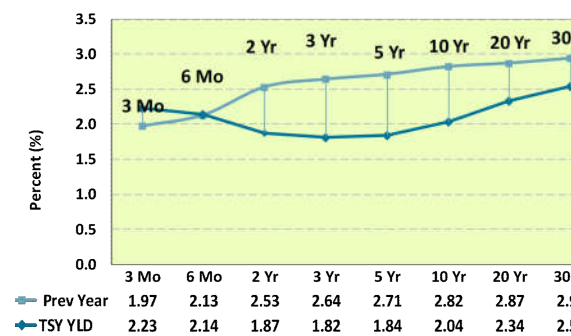
**S&P 500 Sector Returns**

The NASDAQ composite index is a broad-based, capitalization-weighted index of all NASDAQ National Market & Small-Cap stocks. The MSCI EAFE Index is a capitalization weighted index that monitors the performance of stocks from Europe, Asia and the Far East. The MSCI Emerging Markets Index is a capitalization weighted index that monitors the performance of emerging markets stocks from around the world. The FTSE NAREIT ALL REITS Index is a market capitalization-weighted index that includes all tax-qualified real estate investment trusts that are listed on the NYSE, the ASE and NASDAQ.
