

News Headlines

- Hurricane Dorian hit the Bahamas on Sunday as a Category 5 hurricane causing widespread devastation and loss of life. The hurricane continues to linger over Grand Bahama Island this morning as a Category 3 storm. Dorian is expected to impact the U.S. southeast coastal states this afternoon and move up the coastline over the next several days.
- A diving boat in CA caught fire with 39 people on board. Only five crew members were rescued and they are still working to confirm the fate of all passengers.

Economic News

- Tariffs went into effect on Sunday on an estimated \$112B Chinese imports. President Trump says meetings with China regarding trade talks are still scheduled for September.
- The University of Michigan released final U.S. Consumer Sentiment Index last Friday showing the August 2019 Index at 89.8, down from 98.4 in July.
- The U.S. Census Bureau announced last week that new orders for manufactured durable goods increased 2.1% or \$5B in July month-over-month.

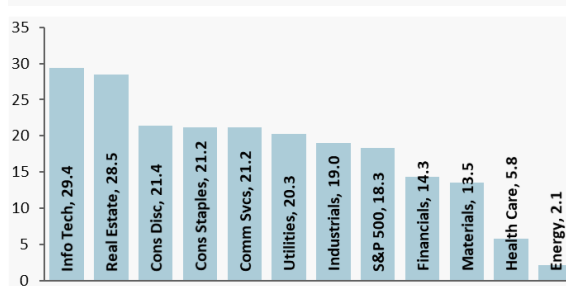

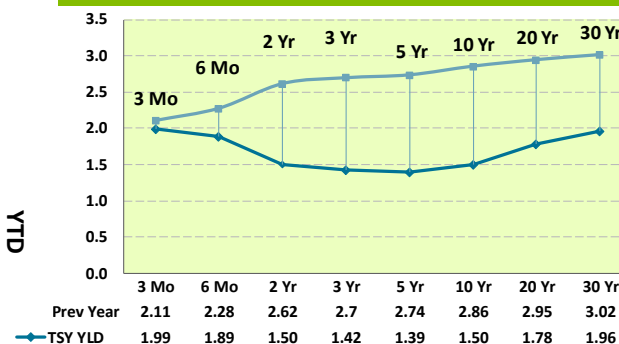
