

News Headlines

- The death toll in the Bahamas is expected to grow as relief workers are still searching the areas devastated by Hurricane Dorian. Thousands of people are now homeless in that area. The Hurricane churned up the east coast and made landfall in Canada over the weekend. High winds and torrential rain has been widely reported with this storm leaving behind flooding in many areas and thousands of power outages.
- Hong Kong's leader Carrie Lam withdrew the controversial extradition bill last week. Protests continued over the weekend.

Economic News

- The U.S. and China agreed to resume trade talks in Washington in early October.
- Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell hinted last week that more rate cuts may be forthcoming at the upcoming September meetings.
- The U.S. Department of Labor announced last Friday that the U.S. economy added 130,000 new jobs in August 2019. The unemployment rate remained at 3.7%. Wage growth was 3.2% year-over-year.

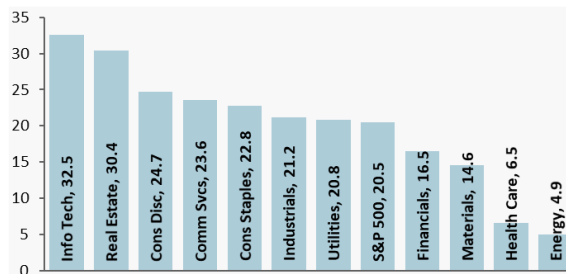

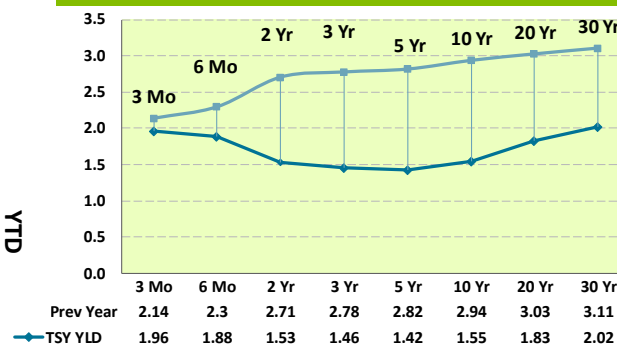
