

News Headlines

- Following last week's delay, U.K Prime Minister Boris Johnson is set to bring his Brexit deal back before Parliament this week, potentially paving the way for the U.K. to leave the European Union after three years of debate and negotiation.
- The U.S. and Turkey agreed to a cease-fire last Thursday to allow Kurdish forces to retreat safely.
- Four drug manufacturers have reached a last minute settlement in Ohio in an effort to avoid a trial over the opioid crisis.

Economic News

- U.S. industrial production fell 0.4% in September, due largely to the GM strike as auto production fell by 4.2%.
- Housing starts fell 9.4% in September following August's 15.1% rise. Also, permits for new construction fell 2.7% following August's 8.2% rise.
- Household net worth in the U.S. rose to \$113T, almost a 100% increase from the depths of the recession in 2009. It is also up nearly 60% from its pre-recession peak.

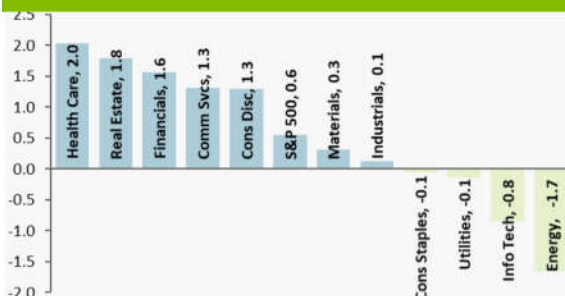
