

News Headlines

- Latest figures show over 14.50M confirmed cases of the coronavirus worldwide with over 606K deaths. The U.S. now has over 3.7M confirmed cases with over 140K deaths. CT has almost 48K cases and 4,396 associated deaths.
- The U.S. set a new daily record of more than 77,000 cases on Thursday as the outbreak continues to surge across the southern states. Vermont is the only state with no COVID-19 related deaths in the last 30 days.

Economic News

- Weekly claims for unemployment benefits fell a 15th consecutive week to 1.3 million last week. Unemployment rates fell in 42 states last month, and rose in 5. Massachusetts (17.4%), New Jersey, (16.6%), and New York (15.7%) had the highest state unemployment rates, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics.
- Housing Starts jumped 17.3% in June to a 1.2 million annual pace.
- Retail sales rose 7.5% in June, are up 1.1% from June 2019, and are just 0.6% below February's pre-COVID high.

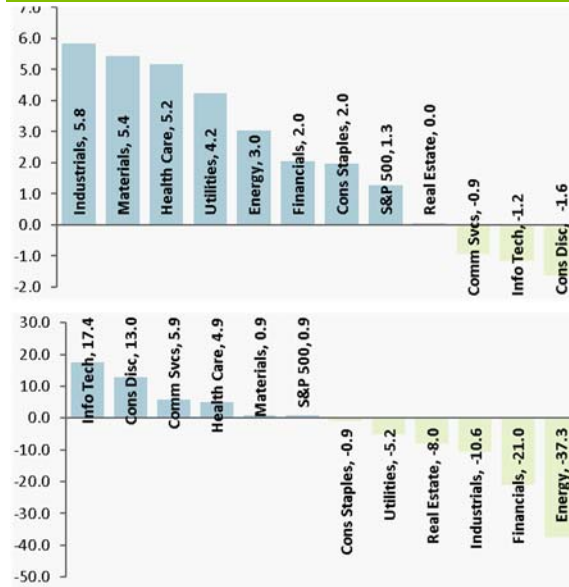

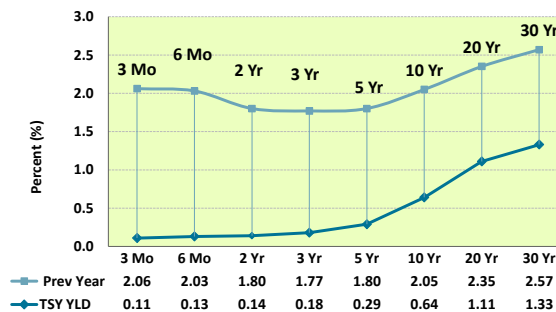

The Dow Jones Industrial Average (DJIA) is a price-weighted average of 30 blue-chip stocks that are generally the leaders in their industry. The S&P 500 Index is a broad-based index of 500 large companies and is widely regarded as an indicator of domestic stock market performance. The NASDAQ composite index is a broad-based, capitalization-weighted index of all NASDAQ National Market & Small-Cap stocks. The MSCI EAFE Index is a capitalization weighted index that monitors the performance of stocks from Europe, Asia and the Far East. The MSCI Emerging Markets Index is a capitalization weighted index that monitors the performance of emerging markets stocks from around the world. The FTSE NAREIT ALL REITS Index is a market capitalization-weighted index that includes all tax-qualified real estate investment trusts that are listed on the NYSE, the ASE and NASDAQ. The Bloomberg Barclays Aggregate Bond Index is an unmanaged index comprised of U.S. investment grade, fixed rate bond market securities including government, government agency, corporate and mortgage-backed securities between one and ten years. The Bloomberg Barclays U.S. Corporate High Yield Index consists of below investment grade U.S. corporate taxable bonds.
