

News Headlines

- Progress on passage of another coronavirus relief deal remains stalled as Republicans and Democrats remain far apart on key provisions and the total cost of the package.
- Cleanup from Hurricane Delta continues this week after it slammed into Louisiana on Friday with 100 mph winds. The storm dumped more than 15 inches of rain in spots causing major flooding and power outages.
- Senate confirmation hearings begin this week for Supreme Court nominee Judge Amy Coney Barrett. Committee Chairman Lindsey Graham's goal is to have Judge Barrett confirmed by the last week of October.

Economic News

- New unemployment claims remained near 840,000 last week while continuing claims fell by 1M to just under 11M.
- The U.S. trade deficit widened to \$67.1B in August, the widest gap since 2006. Global trade is still down 13% from a year ago, but is continuing to recover from the impact of the pandemic.
- The ISM Non-Manufacturing Index rose to 57.8 last month, up from 56.9 in August, as businesses continued to re-open, lifting retail activity.

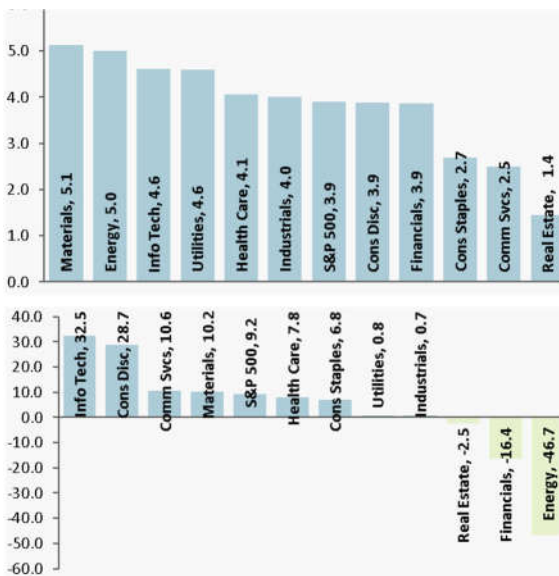

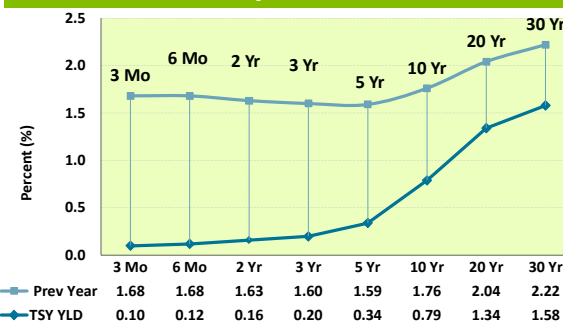
