

News Headlines

- Last week new coronavirus infections surged in the U.S. and news broke over the weekend that a couple of key aides to Vice President Mike Pence tested positive for COVID-19. The Vice President tested negative on Sunday.
- Negotiations regarding another coronavirus relief package appear to have stalled again.
- The Senate will vote tonight and is expected to confirm Supreme Court nominee Judge Amy Coney Barrett.

Economic News

- The U.S. DOL's report on new jobless claims for the week ending October 17 came in at 787,000, down 55,000 from the prior week's revised level of 842,000 and the lowest level since May. Continuing claims fell 1.02M to 8.4M.
- The National Association of Realtors reported last week that U.S. existing home sales jumped 9.4% month-over-month in September to an annualized rate of 6.54M homes, up nearly 21% year-on-year.
- The U.S. Census Bureau released housing starts data last week showing an increase in September of 1.9% month-over-month. Housing starts increased 11.1% year-on-year.

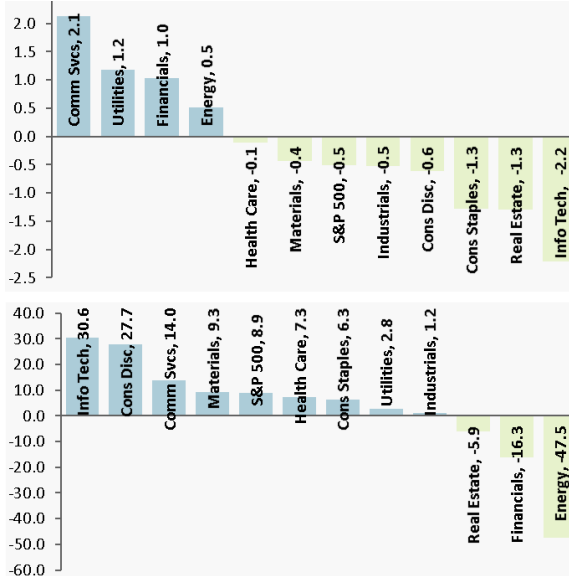

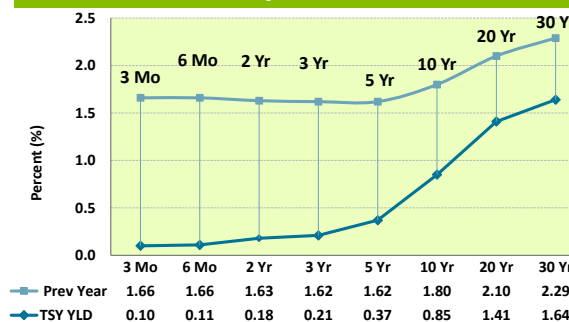
