

## News Headlines

- President Trump signed a sweeping pandemic-aid bill last night, ending a standoff with congress over increasing the size of direct payments to Americans.
- 41 buildings were damaged and 3 people injured Christmas morning in downtown Nashville when someone set off a bomb in an RV. Investigators have identified a person of interest in the bombing.
- The UK and EU struck a Brexit deal on Christmas Eve just days before the year-end deadline, ending years of uncertainty over trade relations following Britain's 2016 decision to leave the EU.

## Economic News

- 2020 Holiday spending rose 2.4% compared to last year's level on strength from online sales which rose 47%.
- Existing home sales fell 2.5% in November from October's level, the first monthly decline in six months as the supply of properties for sale fell to a new low.
- The December 3rd Quarter GDP estimate was revised upward slightly from the November estimate by 0.3%, resulting in an annualized growth rate of 33.4%, this following a 2nd quarter decline of 31.4%.

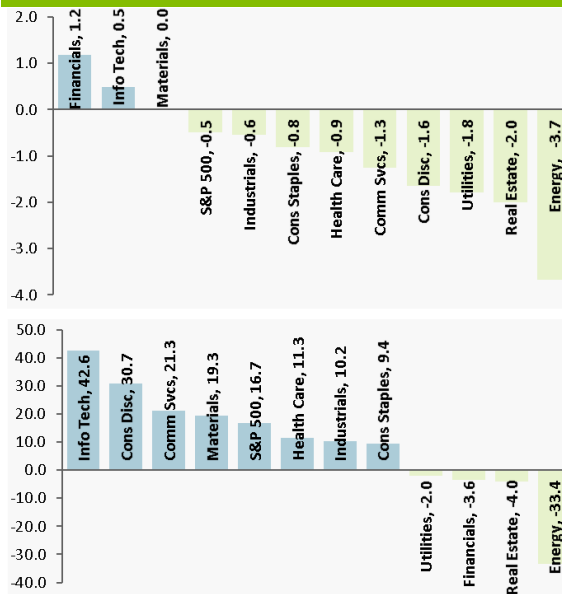
