

News Headlines

- President Biden will meet with top lawmakers this week to push for more than \$4T in additional spending on infrastructure, child tax credits and tuition-free community college.
- According to the CDC, about 58% of the U.S adult population has received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine, with a goal of reaching 70% by July 4.
- On Saturday Governor Lamont announced that 70% of Connecticut adults have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine.

Economic News

- Last week's unemployment report shows that 266k non-farm jobs were created in April, well below the expected figure of 1 million. Regardless, 1.8M jobs have been created so far this year and the U.S. is on track to create 6M jobs by year-end.
- New unemployment claims reached a new low since the pandemic began last year, falling by 92k last week to 498k. The decline was broad-based as claims fell in 41 states and the District of Columbia.
- The U.S. trade deficit hit a new record in March at \$74.4B as imports rose much faster than exports. Nevertheless, total trade volume is up 13.7% vs. a year ago showing that the global economy is continuing to ramp up.

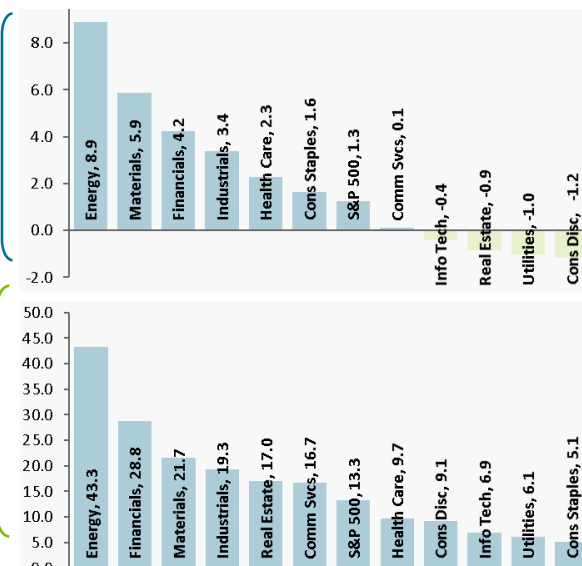

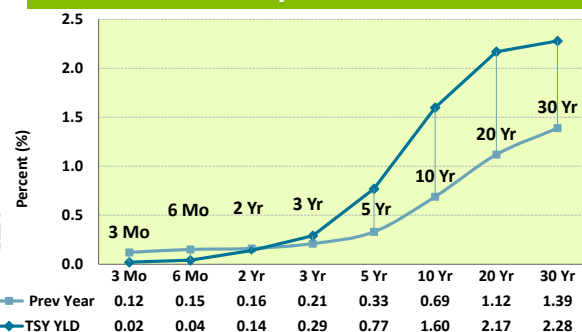
