

News Headlines

- A bi-partisan group of lawmakers is hoping to finalize a \$1T infrastructure deal this week after a group of 11 GOP senators signaled they would allow debate if some of the major issues are resolved and costs have been estimated.
- The heavily favored U.S. women's Olympic gymnastics team stumbled on Sunday as they finished second behind Russia in the qualifying round. In spite of some mishaps, Simone Biles stands atop of the standings going into Tuesday's finals.
- On August 9, Canada will reopen its borders to fully vaccinated Americans. The border has been closed for over a year now in efforts to limit the spread of COVID-19.

Economic News

- Housing starts rose 6.3% in June to an annualized rate of 1.64M as supply-chain issues have eased somewhat. Construction over the last 12 months is the strongest it's been since 2007.
- On Thursday preliminary Q2 GDP figures will be released and are expected to show growth of about 8.5%, following Q1's rise of 6.4%.
- So far 22% of S&P 500 Q2 corporate earnings figures have been reported with 87% beating expectations and 82% beating revenue expectations.

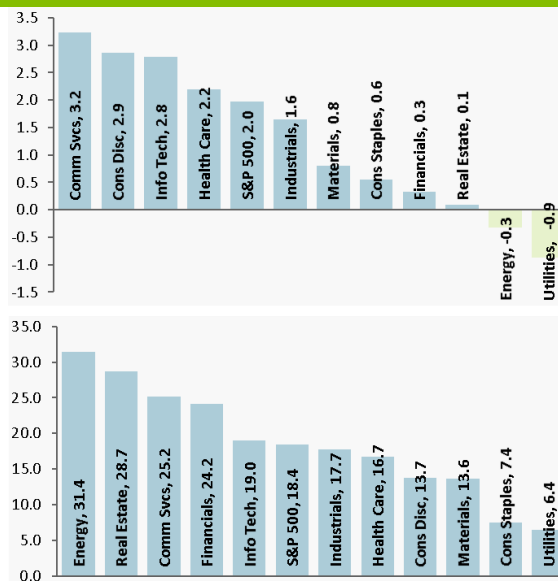

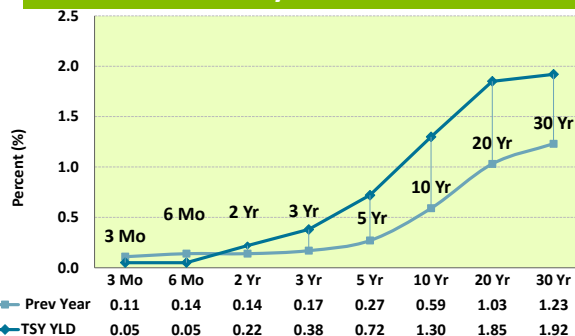
