

News Headlines

- Russian President Vladimir Putin ordered troops into two separatist regions of Ukraine for so-called "peacekeeping functions." As a result, Germany has halted the certification process for the Nord Stream 2 gas pipeline.
- Police in Ottawa arrested over 190 individuals and towed 79 vehicles from downtown streets as Canadian officials moved to end a 23-day protest against vaccine mandates.
- The Beijing Winter Olympics ended on Sunday after weeks of controversy surrounding Chinese government COVID and social media restrictions and charges of human rights violations.

Economic News

- The Producer Price Index climbed 1.0% in January, the biggest increase since last May; overall the PPI is up 9.7% from a year ago.
- Retail sales rose 3.8% in January, led by strong online sales. Retail sales are now up 13.0% year over year and up 23.6% from February 2020 pre-COVID levels.
- Existing home sales jumped 6.7% in January, this in spite of the nearly 1% climb in 30-year mortgage rates so far this year from 3.11% to 3.92%.

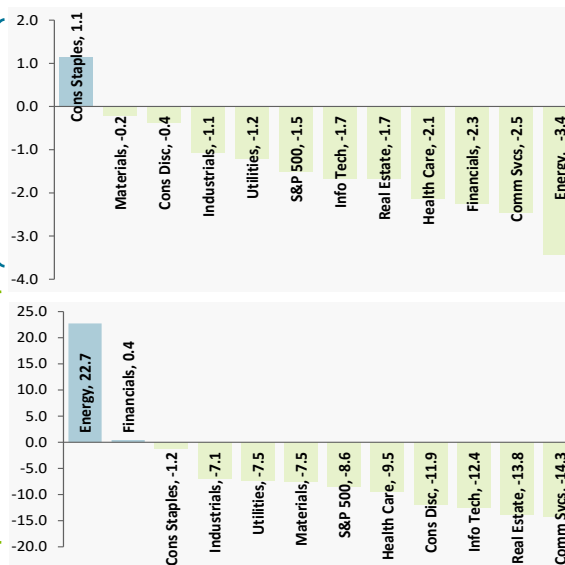

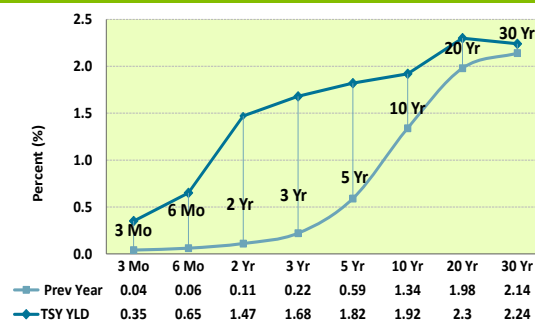
