

## News Headlines

- The Federal Reserve raised its target federal funds rate by 0.75% on Wednesday, the largest rate increase since 1994, in an effort to help dial back historic inflation through increased borrowing costs.
- Ukraine President Zelenskyy predicted that Russia will intensify its attacks this week as European leaders are set to meet at a summit to discuss making Ukraine an official candidate to join the European Union.

## Economic News

- Producer Prices (PPI) rose 0.8% in May and are now up 10.8% from a year ago, as energy prices rose 5.0% while food prices were unchanged. "Core" PPI rose 0.5% in May and is up 8.3% from a year ago.
- Housing Starts dropped 14.4% in May to a 1.55 million unit construction rate, from their highest level since 2006 in April (1.81 million).
- US Retail Sales fell 0.3% in May as six of the thirteen sales categories declined, led by autos and non-store (internet) retailers.

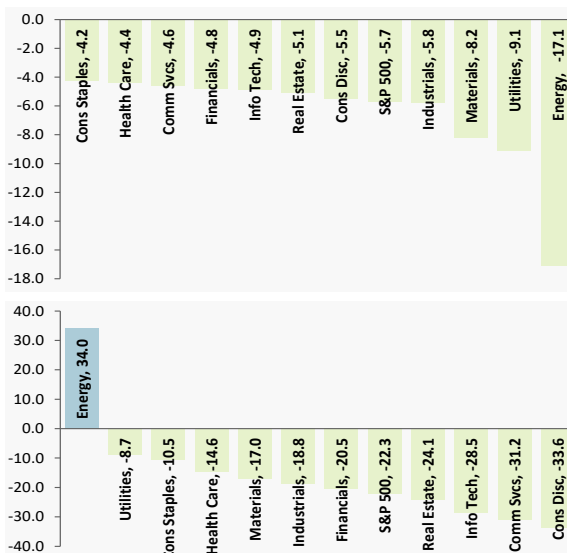

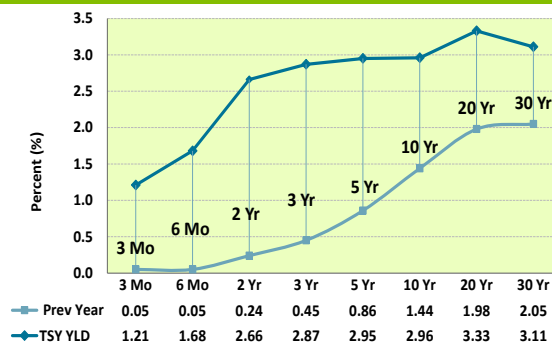
