

Economic News

- The Consumer Price Index (CPI) rose 0.5% last month and has increased 6.4% over the last 12 months. Despite remaining well above the Fed's 2% target, annual CPI has fallen in seven straight months.
- The Producer Price Index (PPI) rose 0.7% in January, higher than the expected figure of 0.4%, after falling 0.2% in December. Annual PPI declined to 6% in January from 6.5% in December.
- Retail Sales jumped 3.0% in January with all 13 sales categories posting gains. This was the strongest monthly rise in almost two years.
- Initial jobless claims decreased by 1,000 to a seasonally adjusted 194,000 last week, a fifth consecutive reading below 200k, the Labor Department said Thursday.
- Housing Starts fell by 4.5% in January and are down 21.4% from one year ago. Building Permits rose 0.1% in January and are down 27.3% from one year ago.

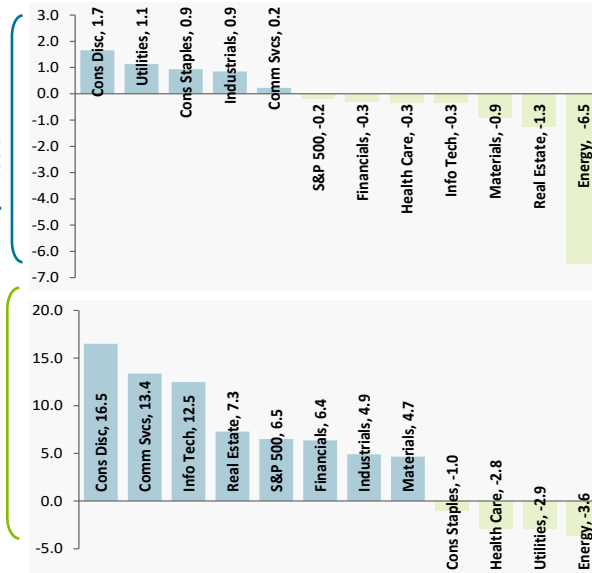

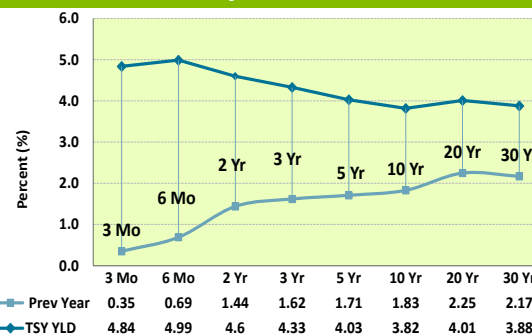

The NASDAQ composite index is a broad-based, capitalization-weighted index of all NASDAQ National Market & Small-Cap stocks. The MSCI EAFE Index is a capitalization weighted index that monitors the performance of stocks from Europe, Asia and the Far East. The MSCI Emerging Markets Index is a capitalization weighted index that monitors the performance of emerging markets stocks from around the world. The FTSE NAREIT ALL REITS Index is a market capitalization-weighted index that includes all tax-qualified real estate investment trusts that are listed on the NYSE, the ASE and NASDAQ. The Bloomberg Barclays Aggregate Bond Index is an unmanaged index comprised of U.S. investment grade, fixed rate bond market securities including government, government agency, corporate and mortgage-backed securities between one and ten years.
